You don't have to choose between economic opportunity and a fantastic quality of life.

You'll find innovation, livability and fun here.

From the ultimate college town of State College to Victorian Bellefonte, to colonial Boalsburg and charming Millheim, our larger towns and quaint villages offer something for everyone.

The people who call Centre County home enjoy a work-life balance that includes short commutes, a historically low crime rate, clean air, farm-fresh food, access to exceptional health care, all-season recreational activities in a breathtaking landscape, and a vibrant social and entertainment scene for people of all ages.

The county is served by five public school districts, each consistently beating state averages in test scores and graduation rates. Educational opportunities are also available through private and charter schools. Business and technical schools also play a vital role in the development of the region's skilled and educated workforce.

Centre County also strives to promote racial, religious and cultural inclusivity and is home to a variety of worship centers and diversity programs.

Centre County is just a short drive from four of the country's 10 largest metropolitan areas — New York City, Washington/Baltimore, Philadelphia/Wilmington/Atlantic City, and Boston. In Centre County, you can attend a Big Ten college football game, see a Broadway-caliber play, visit Amish country, view art exhibits, play in a golf tournament, enjoy equestrian activities, tour a winery, visit a museum, or take in a concert by a top-name performer.

There are more than 750,000 acres of public lands surrounding Happy Valley, making it the perfect base camp for your outdoor adventures. It's a great destination for biking, ATV rides, kayaking, downhill skiing, and camping.

You can hike a mountain, go fly fishing or explore the country's only all-water cavern and wildlife park — and still make it home in time for dinner.

Festivals

The fun begins in July with the Central PA 4th Fest, the largest volunteer-run fireworks display in the country. From there, downtown State College transforms into an art and music lover's paradise during the Central Pennsylvania Festival of the Arts. The People's Choice Festival takes place the same week in July, while just over the mountain, Philipsburg celebrates Heritage Days.

In August, crowds flock to the Centre County Grange Fair to experience the charm and nostalgia of the only remaining tenting fair in the nation. The Grange Fair has been going strong for 148 years and is a home away from home for people who take up residence in 1,000 tents and 1,500 RVs. Penn State's Ag Progress Days is also held in August. It's Pennsylvania's largest outdoor agricultural exposition and features 400 exhibitors from the U.S. and Canada.




Licenses for Field & Stream

Centre County is a mecca for hunting and fishing. General hunting licenses are \$20.97 for adults, \$101.97 for nonresident adults, and \$13.97 for resident seniors. Youths ages 12 to 16 can buy a junior license for \$9.97 if they've completed hunter-safety classes. Additional licenses are needed for bear, antlerless deer and certain other types of hunting. You can buy a license through the Pennsylvania Game Commission (570-398-4744; www.pgc.pa.gov) or at sporting-goods stores.

If you're 16 or older, you must have a license to fish in Pennsylvania. Licenses are \$22.97 for residents, \$11.97 for senior residents, and \$52.97 for nonresidents. Visitors can buy a seven-day license for \$34.97 or a three-day license for \$26.97. If you're fishing for trout, you'll pay an extra \$9.97. Licenses are sold through the Fish and Boat Commission (877-707-4085; www.fishandboat.com), county treasurer's office and sporting goods stores. Rates are subject to change.

Moshannon


Moshannon State Forest derives its name from "Moss-hanne," or "moose stream," the description of the waterway that runs through the area. The forest totals 190,031 acres on the Allegheny Plateau.

Rothrock

Rothrock State Forest is named for Dr. Joseph Trimble Rothrock, a native of Mifflin County and the commonwealth's first forestry commissioner. He is recognized as the "Father of Forestry" in Pennsylvania. Rothrock State Forest comprises 96,975 acres.

Sproul

Sproul State Forest was named in memory of William C. Sproul, governor of Pennsylvania from 1919 to 1923, and is located in north central Pennsylvania. The largest in the state forest system, Sproul covers 305,450 acres.

The northwestern half of Centre County, the Allegheny Plateau, is a forested high plateau divided by deep valleys and fast-moving streams. Despite the richness of its timber stands and the early discovery of coal, the plateau's rugged foothills north of Bald Eagle

Creek discouraged westward-bound settlement and remained sparsely

settled throughout much of the nineteenth century.

Ridge and Valley

The southeastern ridge and valley half of Centre County, made up of forested sandstone ridges and gently rolling limestone valleys, is framed by Bald Eagle Ridge to the north and Seven Mountains to the south. The eastern slope is cut by Spring Creek and the western slope is cut by Spruce Creek.

The discovery of high-quality iron ore brought settlement to this region, as did the richness of its agricultural land.



In Centre County, we enjoy the best of all seasons. Our winters, typically cold with moderate snowfall, usually yield six snowstorms, each with more than four inches of snow. Our springs generally start in early April as the first warm southwest wind moves in across the valley. Summers are beautiful, with warm and moderately humid days. We usually have a spell of hot weather in mid-July. Many here believe the fall season is our best, as deciduous trees turn magnificent colors and the days trend sunny and mild.



All 35 municipalities assess an earned-income tax of 0.5% to 2.05% for the school district.

County homeowners pay a 7.84-mill real estate tax, plus one of the following rates to their resident school district:

Bald Eagle: 58.98 mills Bellefonte: 50.213 mills Keystone Central: 46.24 mills Penns Valley: 48.0995 mills Philipsburg-Osceola: 51.57 mills State College: 46.0875 mills

- Additional real estate taxes range from zero mills in Rush and Burnside townships to 18.26 mills in State College.
- The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania charges a 1% realty transfer tax (collected from the purchaser) and most municipalities charge another 1% (collected from the seller), the proceeds of which are shared between the school district and the municipality.
- Pennsylvania has a 6% sales tax. Exempt items include food and clothing.
- Residents of Pennsylvania pay a flat 3.07% state income tax.



On June 30, 2021, Pennsylvania Gov. Tom Wolf signed legislation to allow college athletes in Pennsylvania to make money through NIL deals. The new law was signed on the same day the NCAA reversed its long-held prohibition against such NIL activity.
